

AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE

Summary

Students who are absent from an examination or who does not submit the end-of-course assessment (ECA) is deemed to have automatically withdrawn from the course. SUSS will not question the student regarding the absence or non-submission.

Under this circumstance, the course will not have a grade and hence no associated GPA. Instead, it will be a 'W' status (to signify that the student withdrew from the course in the semester). The 'W' status will not affect the overall CGPA of the student's academic performance. It will be duly reflected on his/her academic transcript to account for his/her progress.

Following the rules for re-sit and repeat, the outcome of the course will then be either a 'W + re-sit' or a 'W + repeat'.

If it is a re-sit category, the student must take the examination or submit a new ECA in the next presenting semester. SUSS does not limit the number of withdrawals 'W' for each student in the candidature period. Thus, a student may choose to withdraw in the next semester for being absent for the re-sit examination or not to submit the new ECA in the next semester. The outcome of this course in the second semester will then automatically be a 'W + repeat'
